**Statement regarding use of PAP – Processed Animal Proteins – in Fish Feed**

EU Commission Regulation 56/2013 announces reauthorisation of processed animal proteins (PAPs) derived from non-ruminant animals for use in fish feed. The regulation will apply from 1 June within EU and in Norway after formally being included in EEA.

It is worth noting that PAPs derive from carcasses fit for human consumption. Blood meal from swine and poultry has been approved for use in fish feed for some years already.

EWOS AS appreciates the reauthorisation of PAPs. They are considered as sustainable and valuable alternative raw materials.

Due to market considerations EWOS currently do not use raw materials processed from terrestrial animals and a reintroduction of such products in the fish feed will be subject to prior consultations with our customers.
